

By Virtue of a Warrant from the Commissioners of Property dated the 10th day of the 3^d Month in the Year 1720 for three hundred acres of land to Lewis Lewis of Newtown in the County of Chester whereof 125 acres are in Right of Thomas Wynn and John ap John and One hundred and seventy five acres on a New purchase I do hereby Certifie that on the 15th day of June in the year 1720 Was Surveyed for the said Lewis Lewis a Tract of Land in the said County on the Western branch of Comestoga Creek Beginning at a forked Elm tree on the North side of the said branch Thence North north West sixty perches to a Corner black Oak Then by a Line of trees North One hundred forty five perches to a small hickery Then by a line of trees East North East 268 perches to a black Oak Then South 210 perches to a post Then West South West 243 perches to the place of Beginning Containing three hundred acres and the usual Allowance of Six P C^t.
