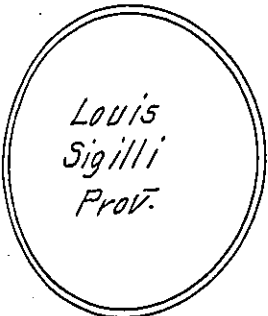


Pennsylvania 55.



By the Commissioners of Property

Whereas 'tis affirmed to us That Colonel Frederic Redegeldt hath lately purchased of the Proprietor Ten thousand Acres of Land in this Province of which he Granted to Lawrence Christopher Nothern two hundred and fifty Acres part thereof to be laid out in the said Province between the River Delaware and Susquehanna which the said Lawrence hath requested of us that he may take up These are to Authorize thee to Survey and lay out in part of y^e Purchase aforesaid to the said Lawrence Christopher Nothern [to be held by him in case y^e s^d Redegeldt's Purchase shall really appear to have been made] the said quantity of two hundred and fifty Acres of Land as aforesaid [according to the method of Townships appointed] that has not been already Survey'd nor taken up nor is conceal'd nor Seated by the Indians. and make Returns into the General Surveyors Office at Philad.^{ia} where this Warr^t is to remain and a Copy thereof to be deliv'd to thee certified by the Secretary Given under our hands and the seal of the Province at Philad.^{ia} the 10th day 10^{br}-1705.
