

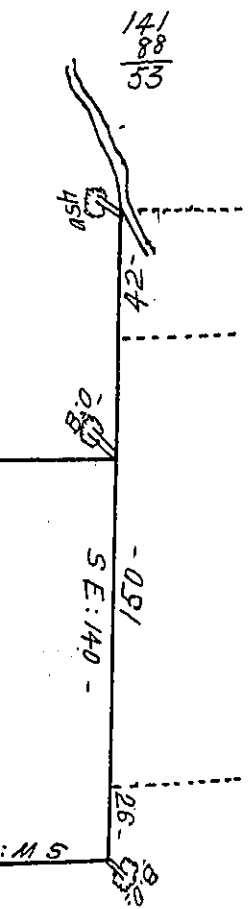
*William Penn Proprietary & Govern<sup>r</sup> of y<sup>e</sup> Province of
