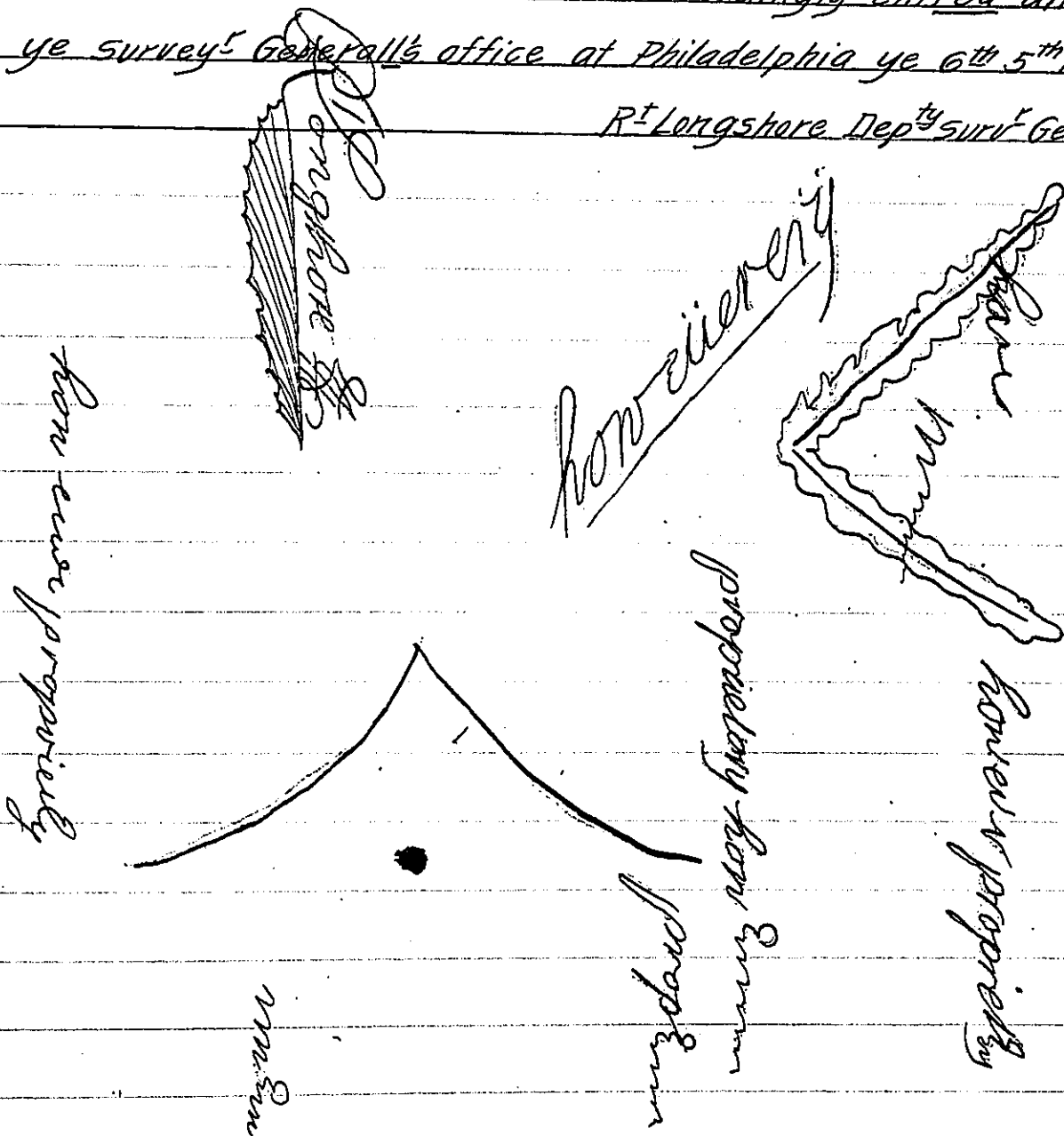


By vertue of a warrant from ye Com^{rs} dated ye 20th of ye 4th m^o 1691 directed to ye survey^r Generall I do by authority from him certifie in to ye secretaryes office that there was surveyed and laid out ye same day unto Patrick Robinson two lots on ye bank of Philadelphia (one whereof was formerly laid out to Timothy Clements and by him sold to ye said Robeson) both of which containeth in breadth thirty foot and lyeth directly oppositt one to ye other The length whereof as followeth from ye Delaware front street to a street of thirty foot broad on ye afore said bank one hundred and fifty foot then from ye east side of ye said street forty-five foot to another street of thirty foot broad running under ye said bank Then from ye east side of ye same one hundred seventy-five foot in to the River Delaware so that ye whole length of ye afore said lot is three hundred and seventy foot and is bounded northward with vacant lots eastward with ye river Delaware at ye afore said extent southward with Jerrymy Elfreth's lots and to ye westward with Delaw^r front street which is accordingly entred and recorded in ye survey^r Generalls office at Philadelphia ye 6th 5th m^o 1691
