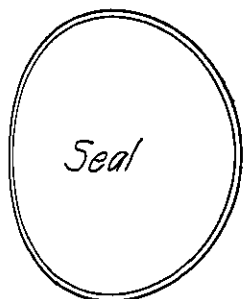

Whereas Henry Hayes having purchased in England the Original Right and Purchase of Richard Hanns to One thousand Acres of Land in this Province the Appurtenant Lots whereof falling on Skuykill Side where they prove inconvenient for a Settlement he hath requested us that we would grant him in exchange of the s^d Lots and for a further Consideration to take up a vacant piece of Ground in the High Street between the third and fourth Streets on the South side containing in breadth thirty three foot These therefore are to Authorize and Require thee to survey to the s^d Henry the said Vacant piece of Ground as bounded with the contiguous Lots and make Returns into the General Surveyors Office at Philad^{ia} where this Warr^t is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delvd to thee certified by the Secretary Given under our Hands and Seal of the Province at Philad^{ia} the fourth day of the 12th Month 1705
