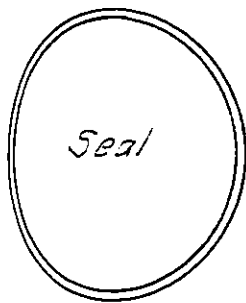

 Land Creeks claimed by the s^d James but not yet allowed reputed to contain
 forty five Acres and make Returns of the fast Land in the s^d James Hunts
 Name and of the s^d Marsh or Meadow distinct into the General Surveyors
 Office at Philad^{ia} where this Warr^t is to remain and a Copy thereof to be
 sent deliv^d to thee certified by the Secretary: Given under our hands and the
