of Pennsylvania & ye Territories therunto belonging.

At ye Request of Sarah Hersett purchaser of five hundred Acres, y<sup>t</sup> we would grant  
her to take up her proportion of Land w<sup>th</sup> in ye Liberties of ye City. These are  
therefore to will & require thee forthwith to survey or cause to be surveyd unto  
her ye said proportion of Land on Delaware side, being eight Acres, she  
improving the same according to Regulation, and make returns thereof into  
ye Govern<sup>rs</sup> Secretary's Office. Given at Philadelphia ye 10<sup>th</sup> 10<sup>th</sup> Mo 1684
