These are therefore in the Proprietors Name to will and Require thee forthwith to survey or Cause to be surveyed unto the before Named Persons the Particular Parcels of Land above mentioned - Leaving about the middle thereof ffiftie foot for a Street, and on the North East side thereof two hundred foot for the Proprietors Convenience and make Return thereof to the Secretaries Office, dated att Philadelphia the 22<sup>d</sup> day of the first Mo<sup>th</sup> 1689
