At <sup>e</sup> Request of Luke Hank, Purchaser of Five hundred Acres, <sup>e</sup> I would grant him  
to take up his Proportion of Land with <sup>e</sup> Liberties of the City of Philadelphia,  
proportionable to his Purchase. These are to will and require thee forthw<sup>m</sup> to survey  
or cause to be survey'd unto him Tenn Acres with <sup>e</sup> Bounds thereof, according  
to <sup>e</sup> method of Townships appointed by me, & make returns thereof into my  
Secretary's Office. Given at Philadelphia <sup>e</sup> 4<sup>th</sup> 5<sup>th</sup> 1683
