

By Virtue of a Warrant from the Commissioners of Property bearing Date the Sixth day of the tenth month A. D. 1711 there was Survey unto William Hear a Lot or Piece of Land in the City Philadelphia Bounded Northward with a Lot now in the Possession of Thomas Story Eastward by the west ends of Second Street Lots Southward by vacant Lots westward with the third Street from Delaware being in breadth fifty foot and in Length One hundred Ninety six foot to be held by him the said William Hearn under under the yearly Quit Rent of five Shillings Sterling Surveyd and Laid out the first of the eleventh in the Year 1711

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this Seventh day of December 1909
