



Pursuant to a General Warrant from the Proprietor and Governour dated the 13th day of March 1684 for Surveying forty thousand acres of Land in this Province to divers Purchasers. Considerable persons of North and South Wales Herefordshire Shropshire and Cheshire There was Surveyd to David Jones One hundred and ~~and~~^{twenty five} acres in Radnor Township in the County of Chester Granted to the said David Jones in Right and as Part of John ap Evans Purchase ~~of~~ of two thousand Acres as it appears by Deed from said John ap Evans dated the first of August 1682 The said hundred and fifty acres of Land Begins at a Post^{at} a Corner of William Thomas his Land and Extends by the same East North East One hundred sixty eight pches to a corner post Then North North West by Edward Griffith's Land fifty three perches to a Post Then West South West by the Widow Preece her Land or Reputed her land two hundred and seventy pches to a post Then by Matthew Jones his Land South South east One hundred and Nine perches to a Post Then East North East by the Widow Thomas her Land One hundred and two perches to a post Then North North West by the abovesaid William Thomas his Land fifty Six pches to the place of Beginning
