By virtue of a War^t from y^e Com^{rs} dated y^e 23^d of y^e 2^d M^o 1692, directed to y^e Survey^r Generall, I do by Authority from him Certifie into y^e Secretaryes office that there was Surveyed and Laid out y^e same day unto Thomas Holme Twenty Eight acres of Land in y^e Libertyes of Philadelphia Sixteen acres, where of is in Right of Richard Gorsly Purches^r of one Thousand acres; and y^e oth^r Twelve acres is in Right of Bartholomew Goppack Sen^r and Jun^r Purchas^{rs} of Seven hundred and ffify acres. Beginning at a Corn^r post standing by Joseph Growdens Land, thence west South west by y^e same Land one hundred and Thirteen perches thence South South East by a line of trees Thirty nine perches and a halfe thence E.N.E. by a line of marked trees one hundred and thirteen perches, thence N.N.W by a line of trees Thirty nine perches and a halfe to y^e place of beginning which is accordingly Entred and Recorded in y^e Survey^r Generalls office at Philadelphia y^e 23^d of y^e 2^d M^o 1692
