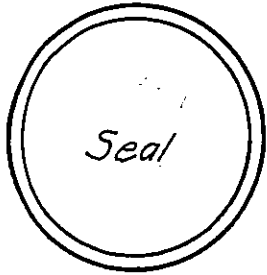


Pennsylvania

By the Commissioners of Property

At the Request of John and Evan Jones That We would grant them a Resurvey on one hundred and fifty three Acres and a half of Land laid out in Goshen by Vertue of a General Warrant from the Prop<sup>rs</sup> For laying out the Welch Tract dated in the first Month 1684 in right of John Thomas and Edward Jones Purchasers of 5000 Acres, and now in y<sup>e</sup> said John and Evan's Possession: These are to require thee forthwith to Resurvey to the said John and Evan the said One hundred and fifty three Acres and a half in the place afores<sup>d</sup> either in one Tract or in two parcels equally divided between them as they shall agree and make Returns thereof into the General Surveyors Office where this Warrant is to remain and a Copy thereof to be deliv<sup>d</sup> to thee attested by the Secretary who is also to take a Duplicate of thy Return into his Office. Given under Our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philad<sup>ia</sup> the 16<sup>th</sup> of y<sup>e</sup> 12<sup>th</sup> Mo<sup>th</sup> 1701
