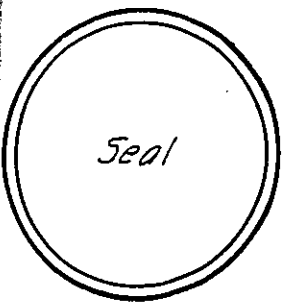

At the Request of Edw<sup>d</sup> Jannigs That We would grant him to take up his Proportion of headland in right of his coming into this Province at the first settling of it a Servant to John Harding of the County of Chester These are to Authorize and Require thee to Survey to the said Edward Jannings fifty Acres of Land in the right aforesaid where not already taken up nor concealed nor seated by to be held under the yearly Rent of a half Penny Sterl P Acre. the Indians, and make Returns into the general Surveyors Office at Philadelphia where this Warr<sup>t</sup> is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delivered to thee certified by the Secretary. Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 16<sup>th</sup> of the second Month 1705
