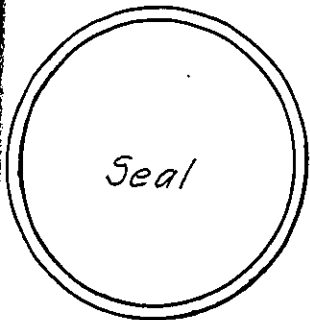

 Philadelphia, where this Warr^t is to remain, and a Copy thereof to be deliv^d to thee
