of acres in Tekony joining to (ob)son, Richard Wall ye younger, according to ye me-  
thod of townships appointed by me, and make returns thereof into my Secretary's  
Office. Given at Philadelphia ye 2<sup>d</sup> 5<sup>th</sup> 1683.*
