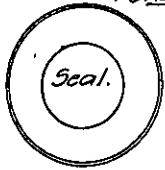


Pennsylvania (661)



By the Commissioners of Property.

At the request of James Thomas of ^{Meirion} ~~Haverford~~ That we would grant him a resurvey on one hundred acres of land Scituate ^{near} ~~of~~ ye township of Haverford in ye Welch tract devised to him by his father James Thomas deceased ~~and~~ being part of 500 acres taken up in the said township by Richard Davies in right of his own first Purchase of 1250 acres. These are to require thee forthwith to resurvey to the said James Thomas the said one hundred acres of land located as aforesaid and now in his possession and make returns thereof into the General surveyor's office at Philadelphia where this warrant is to remain and a copy thereof to be deliv^d to thee attested by the Secretary who is also to take a duplicate of thy return into his office: Given under our hands and the seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 18th of the 12th moth 1701.


