At ye request of John Test, yt I would grant him a warrant to have sett out ye city  
Lott he bought of Charles Pickering fronting ye River Delaware in breadth twenty  
foot ~~and seven foot~~ in length two hundred and seven foot. These are to will and  
require thee forthwith to survey or cause to be survey'd unto him ye said lott as men-  
tion'd in breadth & length, and make returns thereof into my Secretary's office. Given at  
Philadelphia ye 28<sup>th</sup> of ye 1<sup>st</sup> mo. 1683.
