



At the request of John Tyzack that wee would grant him fforty ffot of the Bank of Philadelphia on Delaware River side he promissing to settle it according to ye Proprietors Regulation by wharfing out to Low water mark and building there on &c.

These are therefore in ye Proprietarys name to will and require thee to lay out unto him forty ffot of the said Bank beginning at ye south side of W<sup>m</sup> <sup>Salways.</sup> ~~Markham~~ bank lot, and to proceed ye said breadth southward by and make returne hereoff to ye Secretarys office. Dated at Philadelphia ye 6<sup>th</sup> of ye 3<sup>d</sup> mo. 1689.
