



W(obl-) there was formerlie a grant of land purchased by(obl-) farmer deceased in his owne and ther(obl)eng(obl)as(obl) Major Jasper Farmers name for five thousand(obl-)s of(obl-)d, and Laid outt unto them upon Schuill-kill river(obl-)e County of Philadelphia, and the respective heirs and (obl)ey of the said Major and Jasper Farmers being d(obl)n to have their respective proportions of the (o-b-l.) five thousand acres of land severallie, and a confirmation thereof granted to each of them accordingly.

These are therefore in the Proprietors name to will and require thee forthwith to survey or cause to be surveyed to Edward Farmer three thousand seven hundred and fiftie acres thereof, and to Kathrin (late Farmer now) Billapp Relict and executrix of the said Jasper Farmer twelve hundred and fiftie acres of the said land, in such forme and method as they their guardians and attornies shall agree and make distinct returns hereof to the Secretaries office, dated att Philadelphia the seventh day of the twelfth mo. February 1689.
