acres, all lyeing together in ye County of Philad^a. These are to will
& require ye forthwith to servaie or cause to be servaied unto them five
thousand six hundred acres. Joyneinge together in ye aforementioned County
where not already taken up according to ye method of Townships ap-
pointed by mee. And make returns thereof into my Secretaryes office.
Given at Philad^a the 14th Decem^r. 1683.
