



At ye request of Rich^d Turner that wee would grant him a warrant to take up Three lots for twenty one years between ye fourth and fifth street from Delaware for ye Planting of an orchard the which he hath engaged to plant and fence and at ye terme of years to leave it sufficiently well fenced and planted and yearly to the Proprietary for ye same three English silver shillings.

These are therefore in ye Proprietarys name to will and require thee forthwith to survey or lay out to him the said number of lots as aforesaid and make returne hereoff to ye Secretarys office. Dated at Philadelphia ye 22th of ye first mo. 1689.
