 note is mentioned) maybe confirmed by patent and like wayes ye
 marsh or crippe Lyieng before ye same, between that and ye river
 Delaware which is granted accordingly.

These are therefore in ye Proprietarys name to will and require thee forth
 with to survey or cause to be surveyed unto ye said Robert Turner ye afore
 mentioned marsh or crippe and meadow accordingly and make returns
 thereof into ye secretaries office at Philadelphia ye 26th of ye 9th mo. 1698.
