At ye request of Evan Thomas, Purchaser, yt I would grant him to take  
 up Two hundred & fifty acres of land in ye county of Philadelphia. These  
 are to mill & require thee forthw<sup>th</sup> to survey or cause to be surveyd  
 unto him beyond Skulkill on ye northside of Darby Creek ye sd number  
 of acres in a place not already taken up, according to ye method of  
 Townships appointed by me, and make returns thereof into my  
 Secretary's office. Given at Philadelphia ye 24<sup>th</sup> 1<sup>st</sup> mo 1683.
