


Surveyd and laid the sixth day of the sixth month 1716 by virtue of a Warrt from the Commissioners of Property dated the 30<sup>th</sup> day of the 5<sup>th</sup> month 1716 unto Rich<sup>d</sup> Townsend a lot in the City Philadelphia, between the Third & Fourth Streets from Delaware—bounded northw<sup>d</sup> by Sassafras Street eastward by a vacant lot Southward by the end of Mulberry Street lots and westward by the lot late of John Russel being in Breadth forty nine foot and a half and in Length two hundred fifty one foot.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this eighteenth day of December 1909.
