with to survey or cause to be survey'd unto him ye sd number of acres in ye afore-  
mentioned County where not already taken up, he seating & improving ye same  
with in six Months from ye date of survey & make returns thereof into ye Secre-  
tary's Office. Given at Philadelphia ye 24<sup>th</sup> 12<sup>th</sup> mo. 1684.
