At ye request of Nathanael Allen, yt I would grant him to take
up his City lott proportionable to his Purchase of two thousand
acres. These are to will and require thee forthwith to survey or
cause to be surveyd unto him yt Lott w^{ch} at first fell to him
by lott next to ye Meeting house now, & make returns thereof
into my Secretary's office. Given at Philadelphia ye 5th 4th 1770. 16 (obl.)
