William Penn Absolute Proprietary and Govern^r in
chief of the Province of *Pensilvania* and Counties
Annexed.

At the request of Jedediah Allen, That I would grant him to take up two
hundred and Thirty acres of land, in right of Nicholas Walris Pur-
chase of a Thousand acres, These are to require three forthwith to sur-
vey or cause to be survey'd unto him the said Jedediah Allen, the fore-
said number of acres of land in this Province, not already taken
up, nor survey'd nor concealed, to be laid out according to the Method
of townships by me appointed. He taking out a Patent for the same
within three months after returns shall be made thereof into my Sec-
retaries Office which thou art hereby required to doe ~~at~~ with all con-
venient speed. Given under my hand and seal at Philadelphia the
12th day of the eighth month 1700.
