



William Penn Absolute Proprietary and Governour in chief of the Province of pensilvania and Counties Annexed.

At the request of Robert Addams and others the inhabitants near Taocominck Creek in Oxford Township that I would grant them a resurvey on the severall parcels of land scituate in Oxford Township Claimed or possessed by him the said Robert Addams, John Harper, Rich<sup>d</sup> Busley, Edmond Crpwood, William Busley and John Narrall. These are to require thee forthwith to resurvey or cause to be resurveyed all the said respective tracts of land according to their first bounds and lines of survey and exactly to run straight division lines from and to all the corners by which the said Lands were respectively laid out and make returns thereof into my Secretaryes Office Given under my hand and seale at Philadelphia the 26<sup>th</sup> 2<sup>mo</sup> 1701.
