 Bearing date ye 7th of ye 6th mo 1682. Directed to me I hereby certifie
 into ye Proprietaries and Govern^r Secretaries office yt I have caused
 to be surveyd and set out ye 14th of ye ~~5th~~ said mo unto Robert
 Adams, Purchaser four hundred ninty five acres of land in ye County of
 Philadelphia and in ye Township of Oxford, Beginning at a Corn^r mark
 ed white oak standing by ~~ye~~ Toacorinck Creek being ye Corn^r tree of
 Jno Harper from thence N. E by ye said Harpers line of marked trees
 766 perches to a corn^r marked white oak from thence ~~to the~~
 S. E by vacant land 104 perches to a Corn^r marked white oak from
 thence ^{S. W} by ye land of Tho. Duckett and Henry Waddy 735 perches to
 a Corn^r marked span^(ob) oak standing on Toacorinck Creek from thence
 up ye Severall Courses of ye said Creek to ye first mentioned white oak
 and is accordingly entred and recorded in my office Philadelphia
