


In pursuance of a warrant from the Commissioners of Property dated the 28th day of February 1717⁸ Surveyd and laid out to Martin Urner a certain tract of land on the west side of Schuylkill in the county of Chester Beginning at post by the said Schuylkill at a corner of Matthias Ringers land Thence by the same land south west three hundred and twenty perches to a corner post Thence south east one hundred sixty six perches to a corner post then north east by John Funk's land ~~eastward~~ three hundred sixty eight perches to a black oak by the said Schuylkill ^{about 180 per.} Then up the same on the several courses thereof to the place of Beginning containing three hundred fifty six acres.

Returned into the Secretarys Office the 2^d of 9^{br} 1718.
