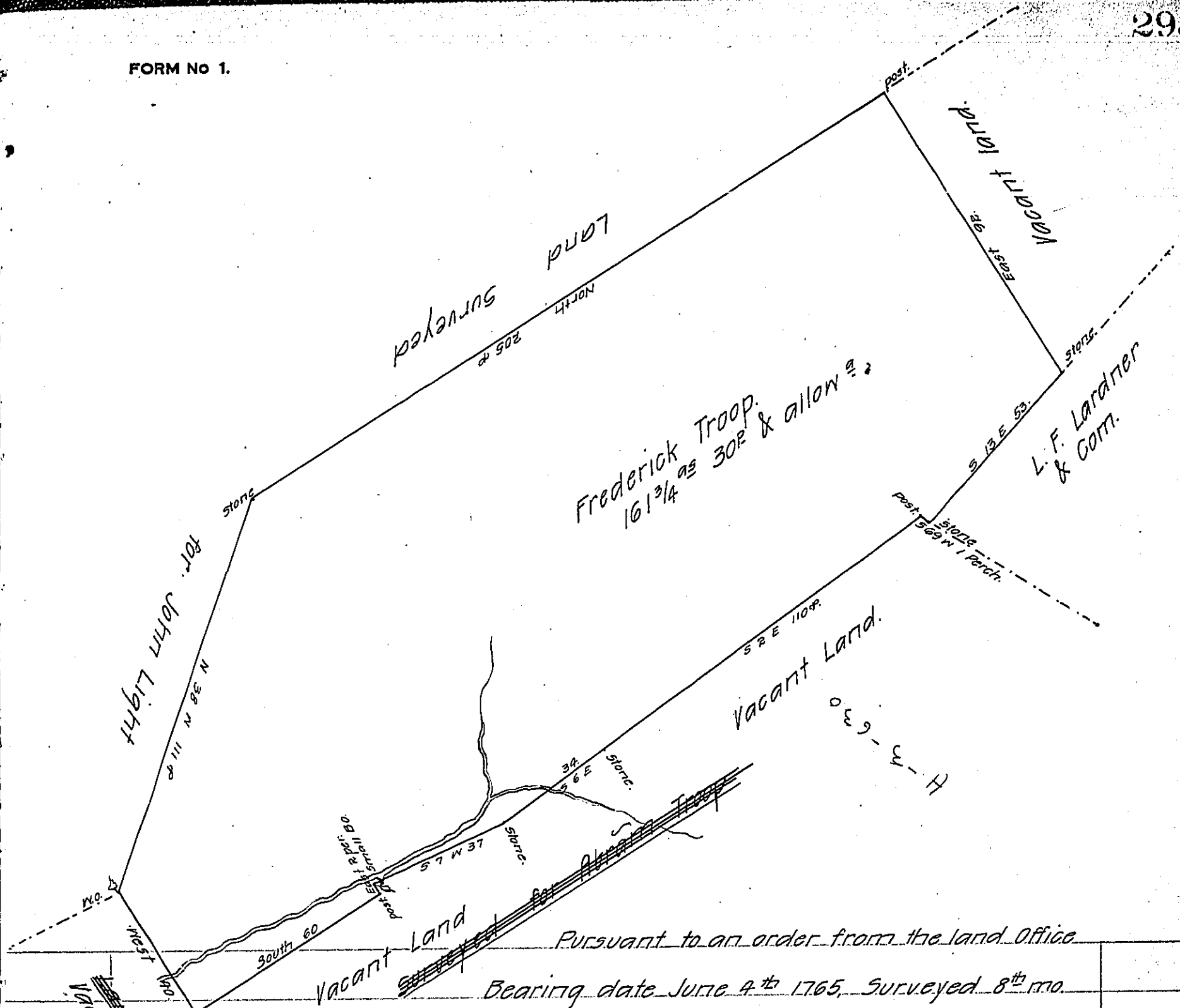


FORM NO 1.



Pursuant to an order from the land Office
 Bearing date June 4th 1765. Surveyed 8th mo.
 21st 1765, for the above named Frederick Troop, the above de-
 scribed Tract of land situate in Garrison Township in
 Lancaster County. P Berija Parvin

Note, The above place by accounts appears to have been settled about seven-
 teen years before the date of ye survey. It is stoney & but lightly Timbred,
 chiefly small saplings & Grubbs, Tho' I think it is rather ye best of all
 the Ten surveyed on this order & likewise has been longest
 settled, therefore Interest & Quitrent Phaps may do, as tis possessed
 by a Poor widow and her son, the above named Frederick Troop
 with some smaller children who have long been a charge upon
 them Berija Parvin

 the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made
 conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of
 February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused
