



By virtue of a warrant from the Commission^{rs} bearing date the 16 day of the twelveth month 1701² to survey and lay out unto Benjamin Furley the Complement of his land untaken up & resurvey the former I certifye into the Surveyors Gen^{ls} office that I have surveyed and laid out to him his Complement of land being one thousand nine hundred acres in the County of _____ Beginning on Schalkkill at a white oak marked for a corner being the bounds of the Frankford Comp^{ys} land Thence northeast by the same nine hundred and fifty perches to a corner marked Spanish oak Thence south east by Va: land Three hundred and twenty perches to a post nere a greate Rock stone Thence south west by land of the London Comp^y 900 ~~perches~~ ^{eighty} six perches (ob:) a Spanish oak marked for a corner standing by the Schalkkill Thence up by the severall courses thereof unto the place of beginning.
