



Pursuant to a warrant from ye Com<sup>rs</sup> of Prop<sup>ty</sup> directed unto me bearing date ye 26: 11 mo, 1702 I do certiey that I have surveyed unto Benjamin Furlo a certaine pece of land in ye city Liberty on ye West sid of Schoolkeel — begining at a stake in the line of Haverford from there by the same west south west 90 perches to a stake neere the Mill Creek from there by the severall Courses up ye said Creek S 39 E 40 perches thence South 12 E 52 perches to a whit ok sapline marked by the said Creek from there by a line of marked trees east north east 94 perches to a stake set in ye ground in a line of William Roberts land from there by a line of Daniell Thomas ~~land~~ north north west 90 perches to ye place of begining Containeing 50 acres of land Surveyd ye 22<sup>d</sup> of ye 1<sup>st</sup> mo. 1703 and returned ye 5<sup>th</sup> day of ye 2d mo. Ensueng into the Generall Survey<sup>rs</sup> office at Philadelphia
