At ye request of ~~James~~ ^{young} Peters, Purchaser of five hundred acres yt I would grant him to take up his lott in ye City of Philadelphia. These are to will & require thee forthwith to survey or cause to be surveyd unto him a Lott on Shulkill side in any of ye Streets sett out for Purchasers of ye like quantity, & make returns thereof into my Secretary's office. Given at Philadelph^{ia} ye 29th 12th Mo. 1683.
