Property and the Seal of the Province dated the 14<sup>th</sup> of X<sup>br</sup> 1702  
Granting unto Matthias van Bebber a Resurvey on 5000 acres of land  
in Right of Dyrick Sipman.

Resurvey'd unto Matthias Van Bebber a Tract of land <sup>Township</sup> in the County of <sup>Comonly called Bebbert</sup>  
Philadelphia beginning at a hickery Sapling at the Corner of Ed-  
ward Lane's land from thence by line of marked trees North  
east one thousand and forty four perches to a stake by a white oak mar-  
ked from thence by a line of marked trees North west nine hundred eig-  
hty eight perches to another stake by a marked black oak then South  
west five hundred and thirty four perches to a stake in William Har-  
man's line then by the sd line South east eighty eight perches to a  
stake. Again by the sd Harman's land South west five hundred and  
ten perches to a white oak at the Corner of the said William Harma-  
ns land. Then South east by Edward Lane's land nine hundred perch-  
es to ye beginning. Containing six thousand one hundred and sixty  
six acres. Resurvey'd by David Powel and Returned into the Gener-  
al Surveyor's Office ye 13<sup>th</sup> 12<sup>th</sup> 170<sup>2</sup>.
