And Whereas the sd Dirick Sipman, as hath been made appear to us, hath Convey'd & made over to Matthias van Beber, now of this Province Merch^t all his right, Title & Interest whatsoever in and to all his Lands in the sd Province & not only to the sd 5000 Acres but also unto one thousand Acres more purchased by the sd Dirick Sipman of Govert Ramkes Original purchaser of ye same from the Proprietary These therefore are to require thee to Resurvey exactly and truly by the first and true Lines of the Original Survey if to be found, the sd Tract of five thousand Acres of Land Scituate in the place afores^d or thereabouts or in what other place soever it may be found to have been duly Survey'd to the sd Dirick if now vacant or not appropriated before the time of ye sd Survey, & make Returns into the General Surveyors Office at Philad^{ia} where this Warr^t is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delvd to thee certified by the Secretary.
