By vertue of a war^t from ye Proprietary & Govern^r bearing date the 28th of ye 4th Moneth 1683, (directed to me) I hereby Certify into his Secretary's Office. that I have caused to be surveyed & set out unto Sam^l Jobson. Purchaser the 20th of ye 8th Mo. last, his Lott in ye City of Philadelphia. Scituated between Wallnut Street formerly called Pool Street on ye North, and Spruce Street formerly called Dock Street on ye South. Containing in breadth twenty foot, and in length from the front street to ye Swamp on the North side of the sd Lott. two hundred and one foot, and from the Swamp to the front Street on ye South side of ye said Lott. one hundred eighty four foot, bounded Northward with William Frampton's Lott, Eastward wth Delaware front Street, Southward wth Humpry South's Lott. Westward wth the Swamp. And is accordingly Entered and Recorded in my office. Philadelphia this 11th of ye 4th Moneth 1684.
