ill side, behinde ye Purchasers, as conveient as may be. forty  
foot front, & in length as other Lotts of y<sup>t</sup> Street run & make ret-  
urns there of into my Secretary's Office. Given at Philadelphia  
ye 16<sup>th</sup> 11<sup>th</sup> mo 1683.
