



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Commissioners of Property bearing date the 5th of the Third month 1719. Surveyed and Laid out for Derick Janson a Certain Tract of land situate in Sacana in The County of Philadelphia begining at a post in the line of His other land thence by that & Vacant land South Seventy degrees West One hundred Eighty Eight perches to a hickery markt for a corner thence by Vacant land South Twenty ^{degrees} East One hundred Thirty Eight perches to a Black oak markt for a corner thence by Vacant land North Seventy degrees East One hundred Eighty Eight perches to a post thence by Vacant Land North Twenty degrees West One hundred Thirty five perches to the place of beginning Containing One hundred and fifty Acres with usual Allowance Surveyed the 27th of May 1725.
