



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Commissioners of Property bearing date the 5<sup>th</sup> of the Third month 1719. Surveyed and Laid out for Derick Janson a Certain Tract of land situate in Sacana in The County of Philadelphia beginning at a post in the line of His Other land thence by that & Vacant land South Seventy degrees West One hundred Eighty Eight perches to a hickery markt for a Corner. thence by Vacant land South <sup>degrees</sup> Twenty East One hundred Thirty Eight perches to a Black oak markt for a Corner thence by Vacant land North Seventy degrees East One hundred Eighty Eight perches to a post. thence by Vacant Land North Twenty degrees West One hundred Thirty five perches to the place of beginning. Containing One hundred and fifty Acres with usual Allowance. Surveyed the 27<sup>th</sup> of May 1725.
