At ye Request of Daniel Jones Purchaser of One hundred Acres. y<sup>t</sup> I would grant him to take up a Lott in ye City of Philadelphia. These are to will & require thee forthw<sup>th</sup> to survey or cause to be survey'd unto him a Lott on Delaware side proportionable to his Purchase, & make returns thereof into my Secretary's Office. Given at Philadelphia ye 20<sup>th</sup> 1<sup>st</sup> mo. 1683.
