

At the request of Bridgett Jennet Relickt & Widdow of Jo. Jennet I certify that abot the 26th of the 10th mo. 1686 there was surveyd unto the said Jennet two Hundred Ninty two Acres of Land within the New Bristol Township in the County of Philadelphia. By warrant from the Survey Gen^l and was Certified into his Office. Begining at a corner post being the bounds of Land and Surveyd for one Pearce a Farmer in the County of Chester. Thence by the same Land 480 perches South west to another corner post. Thence North west by the Proprietors Land 97 perches $\frac{1}{2}$ to a post for another corner. Thence North East by the Land of John Goodson 480 perches to another corner post. Thence South East by a Street or Road 97 perches $\frac{1}{2}$ to the first mentiond place of begining.
