



By Virtue of A Warrant from the Commissioners of Property bearing Date—Day of September 1719. Surveyed and laid out for Derick Johnson In Right of Thomas Parthurst Citizen and Stationer of London, a certain Tract of land Scituate on a branch of Perkiomie— in the County of Philadelphia. Beginning At a white oak, thence by Land Reputed the Societies Land of Jn^o Humstead North East and by ~~vacant land~~ Two hundred and sixteen perches to a post, thence by Vac^t Land South East one hundred fifty seven perches to a post, thence by Vac^t Land South West Two hundred and sixteen perches to a post. Thence by Vac^t Land North West one hundred fifty seven perches to the place of beginning. Containing Two hundred Acres with Allowance of six $\frac{1}{2}$ Cent.
