

Whereas by Warr^t under the Proprietor's hand & Seal to thee directed bearing date the 19th of ye 12th moth 1701 thou was ordered to lay out to David Jones ~~two~~ two hundred and fifty Acres of Land wth in the bounds of the Liberties of Philadelphia to be bounded to the Northw^d with W^m Edw^d & Southw^d with a Line at the distance of twenty perches to be runⁿ parallel with Will^m Warners Land. which Warr^t thou art said to have executed accordingly, but hast not made Returns thereof. Now these are by the Govern^rs Special Ord^r to desire thee in thy Return of ye sd Tract to add the sd twenty perches left out between the same and W^m Warners Line so that the sd Line of W^m Warner be the southw^d bounds of ye sd Davids Land. for w^{ch} this by ye Gov^rs Command will be thy sufficient Authority. Dated at Philad^a 2^d 6^{mo} 1701.
