 These are therefore in ye Proprietary's Name to will & require thee
 to survey or cause to be survey'd unto him his Lott & proportion of
 Land w.th in ye Liberties of ye City (to two hundred & fifty acres purch-
 ase) where they fell, he fenceing in & building upon his City Lott &
 improveing ye Liberty Land according to Regulation and make returns
 thereof into ye Govern^{rs} Secretary's Office. Given at Philadelphia
 ye 19th 10th M^o 1684.
