By Vertue of a warrant from ye Proprietary and Governour bearing Date ye 25<sup>th</sup> of ye 4<sup>th</sup> M<sup>o</sup> 1683. Directed to me. I hereby Certifie into his Secretaryes office y<sup>t</sup> I have Caused to be Surveyd and Set out ye 2<sup>d</sup> of ye 5<sup>th</sup> Moneth 1683 unto John Goodson Purchaser his Lott In ye City of Philadelphia. Scituated between ye Walnut Street formerly called Pool Street and Chesnut Street formerly called Winn Street Containing in breadth fifty one foot and in Length on ye North side of ye said Lott from ye Second Street to ye Swamp two hundred forty three foot and from ye Swamp to ye Second Street on ye South side of ye said Lott 215 foot bounded northward w<sup>th</sup> J<sup>r</sup> Moores Lott. Eastward w<sup>th</sup> ye Second Street from Delawer Southward w<sup>th</sup> J<sup>r</sup> Parsons Lott. Westward w<sup>th</sup> ye Swamp and is Accordingly Entered and Recorded in my Office Philadelphia this 11<sup>th</sup> of ye 4<sup>th</sup> Moneth 1684.
