At ye Request of John Scarborough Purchaser of Two hundred and fifty Acres. y<sup>t</sup> I would grant him a Warrant to take up a City Lott proportionable to his Purchase. These are to will and require thee forth<sup>with</sup> to survey or cause to be survey'd unto him a Lott in ye Streets sett out for Purchasers of ye like value, where not already taken up, and make returns thereof into my Secretary's Office. Given at Philadelphia ye 6<sup>th</sup> of ye 2<sup>d</sup> mo. 1683.
