There was Survey'd laid out the 18th of ye 8th mo 1705 unto Darby Green of Philadelphia five hundred acres of Land (the Original purchase of Thomas Zachary of London Convey d by him to Tho. Hackney of London deceased father of Sarah present wife of the said Green)

Scituate in the County of Philadelphia. beginning at a Post a Corner of Joseph Pihe's land Thence South west by the said Pihe's land 500 pches to a post. Thence North west t 160 pches to a post. Then North east by Vacant Land 500 perches to a post. Then South east to be a post of the Beginning.
