By Vertue of a warrt from ye Prop^ry dated the 4th 19th Month 1682. directed to ye Surv^r Generall. I do for him Certifie into the Secretaries office. That there was Surveyd and Laid out the 11th day of the 10th Month 1682. ~~by Cha^s Ashcom deputy Surv^r~~ for John Scottson. Two hundred accres of Land. on the west side of the School creek. beginning at Swanlums Corner Tree being a Red Oak neare the head of a branch of the School creek and Runing west S:W. Three hundred & ten pches. to A Marked Red oak. from thence S:S:E. Two hundred perch. to A Red Oak. from thence N:E. one hundred and fifty pches To A Marked white Oak. Then N.N.E. Two hundred perch. To A Marked Hickery Tree being a Corner Tree of Swanlums. from thence N. E. & b: E; Eighteen perches To the 1st Corner Tree. Containe^{ing} as aforesaid. Two hundred accres. and is accordingly Entred into the Surv^r Generalls Office the fourth day of the third Month 1694.
